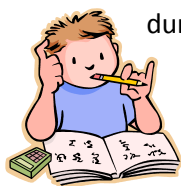


# PTA Summer Enrichment at Lawton Elementary



The Summer Enrichment program is designed to help children continue to exercise their minds and bodies during the time off from school. This summer we are pleased to announce that we have well rounded programs that include drama, hiking adventures, fitness and fun, rock band, rhythmic gymnastics, and math and literacy.

You will have the option of choosing which class you'd like your child to have in the mornings and in the afternoons. Each week looks different so talk to your child and see what he/she is interested in doing!

If you are interested in enrolling your child/children in the Summer Enrichment program, return the registration form to the office as soon as possible.

**Grades:** K-5th - (Grade just completed)

# Class Descriptions

**Cirque Du Lawton** - Join Mrs. Parks this summer by participating in activities that will help you improve your balance, coordination, flexibility, strength and cardio-respiratory endurance! Keep your activity level up by learning or improving your unicycle, juggling, globe walking, yoga, tumbling, bouldering (rock climbing) and dance skills!



## **Drama –**

**Week 1: Circus Camp** - Ever thought it might be fun to run away with the circus? Drama club participants will have a fun filled week of clowning around and parading as animals!

### **Week 2: “Alice in Wonderland” and “Through the Looking Glass”**

Are you a Mad Hatter? Tweedle Dee or Tweedle Dum? Or maybe you’re the Queen of Hearts. Campers will spend the week putting together their own version of the two stories and put on a performance on the last day of camp!

### **Week 3: Kids Americana**

Students will go back in time by eating a snack and learn the history on foods like popcorn, graham crackers, and good old fashion ice cream. We will make old time crafts and play games like marbles and tiddly-winks. Learn how to play a tune on a washboard or make your own hand crafted musical instrument. Students will act out multi-cultural folktales and legends that are a part of the rich history of America.

These classes are available for all students. Older students will have the opportunity to take on roles as directors, stage managers and set designers for the younger students.



**Math and Literacy** - After a great year, now is the time to show off your hard-earned skills in Reading, Writing, and Math! Students will polish their academic skills through hands-on activities designed to enhance current skills and boost students to the next level. Writing and reading skills will have the opportunity to shine through the integration of games, theatre and art. Math concepts will be explored through the use of technology and manipulatives.

**Rhythmic Gymnastics** - Students will get experience with rhythmic gymnastics apparatus (ball, ribbon and hoop) and learn several routines combining dance and rhythmic gymnastics. The students will work on flexibility, endurance and hand-eye coordination while performing fun routines.



**Rock Band** -It’s for kids who love rock music and dream of being in a rock band. Young musicians get the chance to learn to play their favorite rock riffs on electric keyboards, guitars, bass and drums, in a real rock band setting. We invite both experienced and beginner musicians to take part, as there are roles for everyone in our ensemble band! Guitarists and bass players, as well as singers, are welcome to come and be a part of the fun. Instruments are provided for each session, but students are welcome to bring their own instruments if they prefer. Come and jam on music from artists like the Beatles, Macklemore, Michael Jackson, Black Eyed Peas, Taylor Swift and many more.



Join in our songwriting competition with your original tune. Get ready to rock out on the final day live performance. There is a special prize for the best rock star outfit!

**Hiking Adventures** - Enjoy the outdoors and keep fit while getting creative! We will hike from Lawton to...

Day 1 - **Fisherman's Terminal** to sketch boats (except week 2)

Day 2 - **Discovery Park** for creative writing.

Day 3 - **Hiram M. Chittenden Locks** to watercolor.

Day 4 - **Ella Bailey Park** for photography day. Bring your camera and take pictures along the way to one of Seattle’s most spectacular views. Disposable cameras available for additional fee.

Day 5 - **Vertical World** for rock climbing! We’ll end our week with a rock climbing adventure. An additional \$10 climbing fee will be collected separate from registration payment.
